

## The ACT is offered <u>here</u> at LHS in September AND October! A Note About Testing

You basically have four ACT test dates left that you could potentially use for college admissions: September, October, December, or February.

Early Decision or Early Action Deadlines and ACT Test Dates:

If you're looking to apply Early Decision or Early Action (meaning for the most part, application deadlines between October 1 and December 15), you only have **two ACT test dates left: September and October** (and October is pushing it for the November deadlines). Most schools with Early Decision or Early Action options will allow students to submit October scores, but keep in mind you may have to submit your application before you get your scores, and it will be incomplete until your scores arrive. So don't count on October as anything but a backup if you are applying Early; September is the ACT test date for you. Of course, it's not a bad idea to sign up for October as well when you sign up for September. Registration deadlines for October will have passed by the time you get your September scores.

Remember that students on free/reduced lunch are entitled to TWO fee waivers during their high school career. Please see a Guidance Counselor if you qualify for a waiver!
