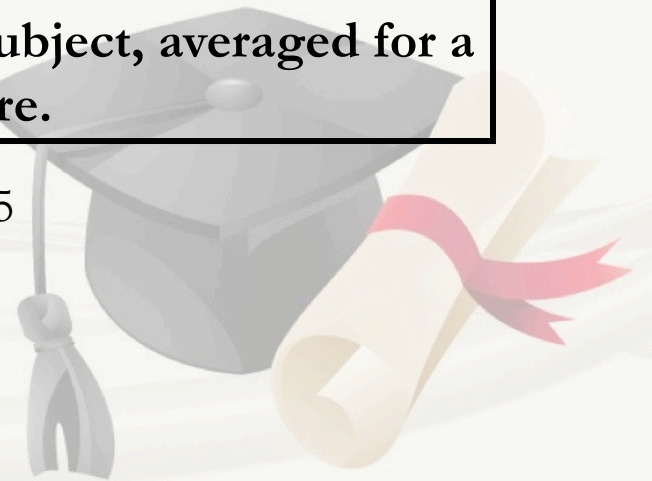
Entrance Exams

7 Times a Year	6 Times a Year
Critical Reading Math Writing section (essay)	English Math Reading Science Reasoning Writing/Essay is optional but required by most schools
Each Section is worth 200-800 points for a maximum of 2400	1-36 for each subject, averaged for a composite score.

- STAR student is the senior with the highest SAT score. Nov 5 is the last test date that is considered
- Technical colleges may **only** require Compass Testing (given on the college campus).

Visit the Campus

- Each senior has 2 visitation days they can take anytime during their senior year.
- You must bring confirmation from the campus you have visited and turn it into the Attendance Office for your absence to be counted as a field trip.



Keep your options open!

- Apply to more than one school.
- Typically students apply to 3 schools:
 - **Dream Schools** – may not get in, but is their top choice
 - **Reach Schools** – student stands a good chance of admission
 - **Safety School** –
backup plan in case they need it

- Paper applications (some still available)
- Apply as an undergraduate
- Deadlines are CRITICAL!
- Goal – Apply by Thanksgiving

HOPE

○ Zell Miller Scholarship

- 3.7 GPA in academic classes
- 1200 on the math and reading portions of the SAT test or a 26 composite score on the ACT test in a single test administration.
- Also can be Valedictorian or Salutatorian

○ Hope Scholarship

- 3.0 GPA in academic classes

○ HOPE Grant

- No GPA requirements
- Designed for Technical College certificate and diploma programs

 - **You will need to complete the FAFSA each year.**
